Story 1

God Loves You Always

— John 3:16 —

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

Long ago, God looked down at the world He had made. He saw every person — every man, every woman, every child. And He loved them all deeply.

God wanted His people to know how much He cared for them. So He made the greatest gift anyone has ever given. He sent His Son, Jesus, to come and live among us.

Jesus was born as a tiny baby in Bethlehem. He grew up, walked among the people, and healed the sick. He was kind to everyone He met.

Then Jesus gave His life so that our sins could be forgiven. He died on the cross and rose again three days later.

God did all of this because of love. Not because we were perfect. But simply because He loves us.

And here is the most wonderful part — that love has never stopped. God loves you today just as much as He did then. You are held in the arms of a God who loves you forever.

Story 15

The Deaf Man Hears Again

— Mark 7:32-35 —

“And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain.”

People brought a man to Jesus who could not hear and could not speak clearly. They begged Jesus to help him.

Jesus took the man aside — away from the crowd. He wanted the man to feel safe and cared for. He was not a spectacle. He was a person deserving of dignity and care.

Jesus put His fingers gently in the man’s ears. He touched his tongue. He looked up to heaven and said one word.

Ephphatha. Be opened.

And immediately the man’s ears were opened. His tongue was freed. He could hear. He could speak clearly.

When you feel like no one hears you — Jesus hears you. When words are hard to find — Jesus understands your heart. He touches the places where we hurt most and says — be opened. Be healed. Be free.

Story 8

God Is Always Watching Over You

— Psalm 121:7-8 —

“The Lord shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul. The Lord shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.”

The writer of this psalm was thinking about a journey. In those days, travel was dangerous. There were steep hills and rocky paths.

But the psalm writer had no fear. Because he knew that God was watching over him every step of the way.

God does not sleep. God does not look away. God does not get distracted or forget about you.

He watches over your going out — every time you leave a familiar place. He watches over your coming in — every time you return. He watches over your soul — the deepest part of who you are.

Some days you may feel unsteady or lost. Some days the world feels too big and too hard.

On those days, remember — God’s eyes are on you. He knows when you are tired. He knows when you are afraid. And He is right there, keeping watch, just as He always will be.
